

# KIDS INC.

The Kids inc. program is designed for those children from birth to age five who accompany their mothers during Moms inc. meetings.

As with all FBCL preschool education opportunities, our teaching staff is dedicated to positive learning experiences. We want to meet the spiritual, emotional, mental, physical, and social needs of your child in a warm and loving Christian environment. Maureen Gibson, Childcare Coordinator at First Baptist Church of Lewisville, makes room assignments and coordinates childcare workers for Kids inc. ## General Policies

1. Regular attendance is required to hold your child's place in Kids inc. There is a waiting list for childcare; therefore, your child's spot will be forfeited after 3 consecutive absences. If at any time you choose alternate childcare, please let us know so we can fill the spot.
2. Parents are required to label all items belonging to their child (diaper bags, bottles, pacifiers, etc.). This is to eliminate lost articles.
3. Please bring only disposable diapers.
4. Children should not bring toys, books, or other material from home. These items are easily lost and difficult to share. We cannot be responsible should these items become lost.
5. Please bring an extra change of clothes.
6. For health reasons, First Baptist Church of Lewisville will not wash soiled clothing.
7. Only children of women attending Moms inc. will be allowed to participate in Kids inc. (We cannot allow other children for whom you may be caring.)
8. Moms must be participating in Moms inc. activities the entire time their children are in Kids inc. (no leaving for dr. appointments, errands, etc.).
9. For safety and hygiene reasons, only FBC workers are allowed in the Preschool classrooms.

## Feeding

1. Please feed your child breakfast before you come.
2. Plastic bottles and sippy cups are acceptable, no glass.
3. Infants will be fed formula, milk, juice, or water when provided by parents in plastic bottles. A nursing room is provided near the classrooms for mothers to nurse their infants.
4. A snack of water, saltines, animal cookies, graham crackers, or cheerios will be served to the older children during Moms inc. meetings. If at any time there is a special snack provided, you will be alerted in advance.
5. Parents must report any serious allergies, problems, or peculiarity of feeding, etc. to teachers.

## **Illness and Medication**

1. For the protection of your child and other children, moms are requested not to bring a child who appears ill. The Committee on Control of Infectious Diseases of the American Academy of Pediatrics recommends a child not be taken from home when any of the following conditions exist or have existed in the last 24 hours:
  - a. Fever
  - b. Vomiting or diarrhea
  - c. Any symptoms of childhood diseases, such as scarlet fever, German measles, mumps, chicken pox, or whooping cough.
  - d. Common cold – from onset through 1 week.
  - e. Sore throat
  - f. Croup
  - g. Any unexplained rash
  - h. Any skin infection, boils, ringworm, impetigo
  - i. Pink eye or other eye irritations
  - J. Communicable diseases
  - K. Evidence of lice or nits

**If you or anyone in your household has tested positive for COVID,  
please wait until you are in the clear to attend.**

**WHEN IN DOUBT, PLEASE KEEP YOUR CHILD AT HOME.**

2. Children who appear ill during any session will be isolated; the mom will be contacted to take the child home immediately.

If your child contacts a communicable disease, please inform the Kids inc. coordinator so she may inform other parents to take preventative action.
